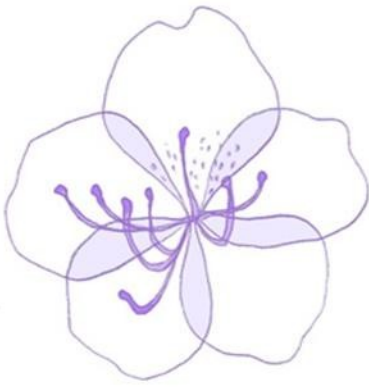

Sri Lanka ?!

Sri Lanka is a strategic naval link between West Asia and South East Asia. It has also been a center of the Buddhist religion and culture from ancient times as well as being a bastion of Hinduism. The Sinhalese community forms the majority of the population; Tamils, who are concentrated in the north and east of the island, form the largest ethnic minority. Other communities include Moors, Burghers, Kaffirs, Malays and the indigenous Vedda people.

The country is famous for the production and export of tea, coffee, coconuts, rubber and cinnamon which is native to the country. The island also boasts the first female Prime Minister in the world, Sirimavo Bandaranaike.

After over two thousand years of rule by local kingdoms, parts of Sri Lanka were colonized by Portugal and the Netherlands beginning in the 16th century, before control of the entire country was ceded to the British Empire in 1815. During World War II, Sri Lanka served as an important base for Allied forces in the fight against the Japanese Empire. A nationalist political movement arose in the country in the early 20th century with the aim of obtaining political independence, which was eventually granted by the British after peaceful negotiations in 1948.

Names of Sri Lanka ?!

In ancient times, Sri Lanka was known by a variety of names: ancient Greek geographers called it Taprobane and Arabs referred to it as Serendib (the origin of the word "serendipity"). Ceilao was the name given to Sri Lanka by the Portuguese when they arrived in 1505, which was transliterated into English as Ceylon. As a British colony, the island was known as Ceylon, and achieved independence under the name Dominion of Ceylon in 1948.

In 1972, the official name of the country was changed to "Free, Sovereign and Independent Republic of Sri Lanka". In 1978 it was changed to "Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka". The current name is derived from the Sanskrit with the word Lanka, meaning "island", also being the name of the island as described in the ancient Indian epics Mahabharata and the Ramayana. The word Sri is a Sanskrit title meaning "venerable".

Religions

Sri Lanka has a multi ethnic and multi religious population. Buddhism constitutes the religious faith of about 70% of the population of the island, most of whom follow the Theravada school of Buddhism. According to traditional Sri Lankan chronicles, Buddhism was introduced into Sri Lanka in the 2nd century BCE by Venerable Mahinda, the son of the Emperor Ashoka, during the reign of Sri Lanka's King Devanampiyatissa.

Sri Lanka has the longest continuous history of Buddhism of any predominately Buddhist nation, with the Sangha having existed in a largely unbroken lineage since its introduction in the 2nd century BCE. During periods of decline, the Sri Lankan monastic lineage was revived through contact with Thailand and Burma.

Hinduism the second most prevalent religion in Sri Lanka and it also arrived from India. Today, most Hindus are Tamil and they constitute a majority in Northern Sri Lanka.

Religions which today exist in Sri Lanka, in addition to Buddhism and Hinduism include Islam as well as different churches of Christianity. Followers of Islam comprise nearly eight percent of the population, having been brought to the island by Arab traders over the course of many centuries, most are Sunni who follow the Shafii school.

Hinduism was primarily established in Sri Lanka by migrants and often invaders from southern India, Hindus constitute just over 7 percent of the population, mostly of the shaivite school. European colonists introduced Christianity to the country in the 16th century, and the religion has been adopted by around six percent of the population.



European colonists established a series of tea, cinnamon, rubber, sugar, coffee and indigo plantations. The British also brought a large number of indentured workers from Tamil Nadu to work in the plantation economy. The city of Colombo was established as the administrative centre, and the British established modern schools, colleges, roads and churches that brought Western-style education and culture to the native people.

Increasing grievances over the denial of civil rights, mistreatment and abuse of natives by colonial authorities gave rise to a struggle for independence in the 1930s, when the Youth Leagues opposed the "Ministers Memorandum," which asked the colonial authority to increase the powers of the board of ministers without granting popular representation or civil freedoms. Buddhist scholars and the Teetotalist movement also played a vital role in this time.

During World War II, the island served as an important Allied military base. A large segment of the British and American fleet were deployed on the island, as were tens of thousands of soldiers committed to the war against Japan in Southeast Asia.

Dominion of Ceylon Independence



Following the war, popular pressure for independence intensified. The office of Prime Minister of Ceylon was created in advance of independence on 14 October 1947. Don Stephen Senanayake being the first prime minister. On February 4, 1948 the country won its independence as the Dominion of Ceylon.

On July 21, 1960 Sirimavo Bandaranaike took office as prime minister, and became the world's first female prime minister and the first female head of government in post-colonial Asia. In 1972, during Sirimavo Bandaranaike's second term as prime minister, the country became a republic within the Commonwealth, and the name was changed to Sri Lanka. The island enjoyed good relations with the United Kingdom and had the British Royal Navy stationed at Trincomalee

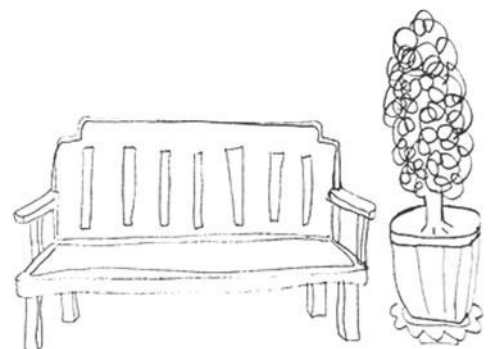

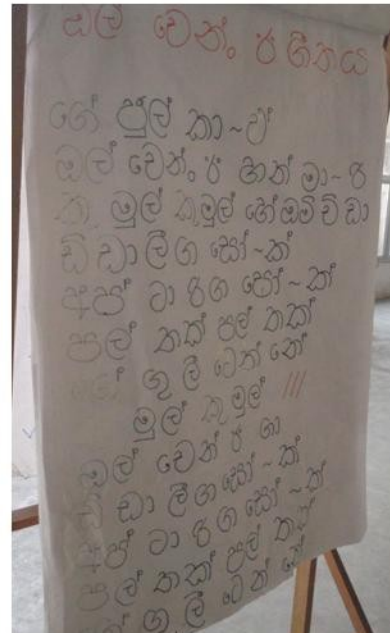

Inside, RaonAtti team wanted to speak Sinhalese for communication.

In class, everyone sang a song without music, and talked about contents of song. Thanks to second RaonAtti team, there were good lyrics which wrote on big paper. Many children imitated how to sing and dance, but some children looked like being bored. Possibly, the song was same thing before, so that's why some children were not interested in singing and dancing. After finishing a song, everyone did funny clapping with classmates. Many children were enthusiastic, and they responded about that instantly. They were ready to move same motion like jumping and clapping, and waited to hear 'start'. There was no hesitation to clap each other regardless of male and female. It was nervous for me to see when children expected to do next movement.

When I feel uncomfortable to progress class, Ashoka joined and made class humorous as doing games. For instance, there were some movements that everyone made such as tiger, person, and gun. Before making one movement, children discussed to decide which one they would choose. In that case, they needed to accept different opinion, and manage decision. If they conflicted with different ideas, they would be lost.

In addition, it was a lot of passion about throwing shoes and hitting a target. If they could hit a target, their faces were full of pleasure. On the other hand, their faces were distorted by regret when they lost. Many children enjoyed games regardless of victory and defeat. I, who was crying boy whenever defeated, learned a meaning of enjoyment from them. I remembered Sri Lanka children called RaonAtti names one by one sincerely such as Isuru, Maduri, Sanduni, Piyumi, and Lahiru.

Sanduni The children didn't care winners; rather, they enjoyed a game together regardless of victory and defeat. It was really impressive.

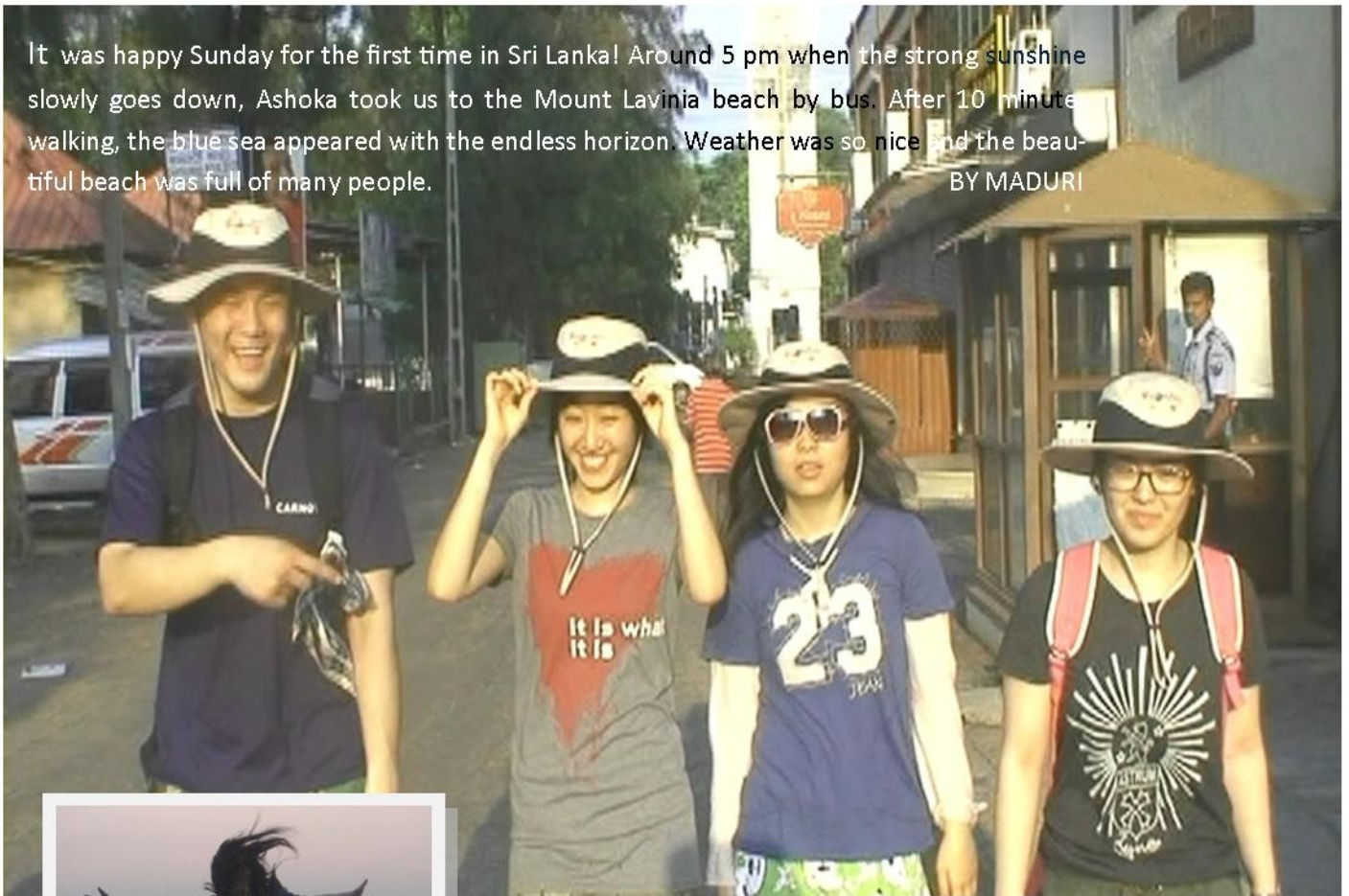
Lahiru It was fabulous time because I played game with children and learned Sinhalese as imitating what they said.

Planting Tree Project

Maduri Planting trees was our first project. I had never cut the trees with a saw and my hammer skill was so poor before. However, I had a very good experience through the project. During last 3 days, I learned how to saw woods and how to hammer a nail in a right way. Finally, we made 30 frames for trees, and they looked so beautiful standing in a row on the center of the road. Besides, I planted trees for the first time in my life. I had never done it before. With loving heart, I put the small trees in the old and gave them good soil and water.

However, there was one thing I found as a big problem of Moratuwa, which was the air. While I was planting the trees, I had to work between two roads and the air was so terrible that I could barely breathe. I could see some signboard around on which “drive green” was written which was of no use. Every car emitted bad black gasses passing the roads. I think, Moratuwa, to be a better place, needs something for the air. In addition, our first project, planting the trees on the road, will take a good role in the future. I wish them to grow very well, so someday in the future when I come back to Sri Lanka, I could see the 30 trees make road super green and give Moratuwa clean air.

Isuru This first project was high level, so I was responsible to do well. Everyone was energetic, and united. In first time, we couldn't recognize what we should do like putting nails, cutting woods, and tying wires. As time is going, we could figure out proper positions. In addition, I could reflect a value of labor and money; for example, I worked with Michael Jackson, and saw that he got 200 rupees. In case of Korean labor, many workers get 2,000,000 rupees. It was reflective time for me to consider Sri Lanka situation.

Piyumi I did my best because it was the first project. Cutting the trees and enduring strong heat outside, I was joyful when the frames were completed one by one. Honestly, I doubted if we can make 30 frames. But after all, I felt proud and happy because the result was so successful. We helped each other and passed through each process together. Anyway I hope that all trees grow well. :)

Sanduni It could be more effective if I have some equipment like drill. I was curious about supplying good woods, but I cut bamboos to make frames. I was a volunteer of Habitat which is a group to create houses for homeless people. Based on my experience, I enjoyed cutting woods, putting nails, and making frames. I can work in here so many times. I couldn't forget what I didn't arrange YMCA's field after working. I am considering what I should have arranged the field. I want to make sure that I put equipment in order. I doubted whether many trees would be grown well because of smoke. However, the big can be accomplished from the small. It was good time to plant trees after a week because I could understand and adjust such situations.

Lahiru I would like to face Sri Lanka sunshine, but my skin couldn't endure that. It was first time to cut woods, put nail, and make frames. I was painful and satisfied about making frames by hand. I need to be more slow and detailed than before. I used to miss putting nail and tying ropes when I tried to do fast. I learned an artisan spirit from Michael Jackson's rough hands and feet. I perceived some his humanism when I saw his smile to show his teeth and eyes' wrinkle. It looks like being humble and vigor. I was sorry about what I didn't arrange equipment after working on Tuesday, 9th March. I remembered teammate's conditions such as working silently and wearing a frown because of hammer. It was bittersweet memory.

Team's opinion We could understand how we could manage time and positions. In addition, we could recognize how we have different physical ability and endurance. Most importantly, we were willing to sacrifice for improving Moratuwa environment. We hope that green will be full of Moratuwa city by planting trees.

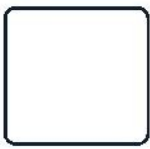
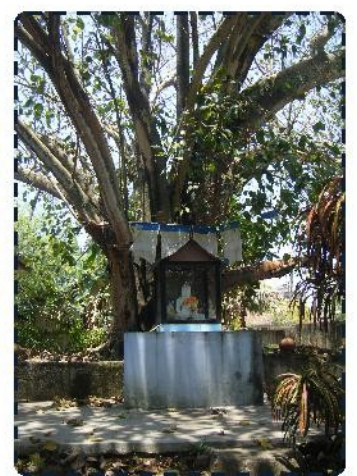
10. GENERAL HOSPITAL HERBAL HOSPITAL



Our second project! Make signboards for the patients of General hospital! There are 2 hospitals in Moratuwa- General hospital, Herbal hospital. General hospital literally gives patients general treatment and Herbal hospital gives only herbal treatment. General hospital has many places which don't have signboard, so many patients who come to the hospital for the first time feel difficult to find pharmacy or wards. To visit the Herbal hospital first, Ashoka and we, 5members, walked along the long beach for 20minutes under the strong sunshine from the YMCA. On the way to go, while we saw a row of small apartments on the right side of the road, we could see many shabby houses made with woods on the right side. Ashoka said that the apartments were built by Sri Lanka government after the people living around the beach took a huge damage from Tsunami. It's good for the people who live in apartment now. However I felt pity for the people who still live in difficulties after losing their houses and they reminded me of those suffering from the floods every year in Korea.



We found the doorplate of Herbal hospital with a green front gate. The hospital was like a cluster of two or three small houses. We tried to see the big doctor but he was too busy for performing an operation. We looked around the hospital garden instead. There were many plants and aloe for medicinal use in flowerpots. Some plants were planted by Raon-Atti 2nd batch and growing well.

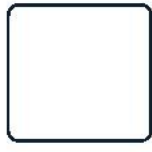

OUR OPINION



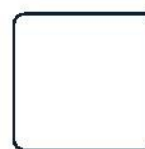

Above all, patients looked very serious such as skeleton. One man was suffered from tetanus, and the other groaned due to painfulness. Those made me sore like piercing my mind.

SANDUNI There were some dogs, cats, and birds living in hospital. It was unbelievable for dogs to enter the hospital. Many dogs were living in Moratuwa, but dogs shouldn't be allowed to enter for hygiene. Wandering dogs could be one of local feature in Moratuwa, but it should be improved. Also, I hoped signboards which we were going to make would be helped for patients using hospital facilities.

LAHIRU First hospital looked like a kind of garden because it was full of herbs. It was very tranquil and peaceful to make patients calm. In second hospital, there were many patients who just lay on beds without chemical medicines. I hoped recovery would be fast for them.

9 o'clock in the morning, after watering the plants that we planted on the road, Ashoka and RaonAtti 5 members got started on our new work. This new work is about the Smile Moratuwa Project that 2nd batch had done last year. Smile Moratuwa project was started because of food garbage problem of the city. Before using compost bin, people just dumped food garbage on the street. The municipal office took the garbage but before that the smell was terrible and didn't look good. 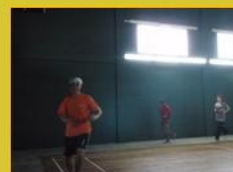
YMCA Badminton class 2 [13th March 2010]

13. HERBAL DRINK PROJECT OPINION

Whenever anybody visited or is invited to a house in Sri Lanka, Ceylon tea always comes out for guests. Ceylon tea is generally divided into plain tea and milk tea; it is very sweet tea like most Sri Lanka drinks. It is very pleasurable about the scent and sweet taste, but many people are suffering from diabetes. If you get a disease in Sri Lanka, you need to cure that like Sri Lanka style. For example, there are many hospitals using herbal remedies. It's very similar to Oriental medicine.

As if Sri Lanka people provide Ceylon tea for us, we hope their disease will be cured by providing herbal drink. I can't wait next week.

On Saturday, 20th March 2010, the first taekwondo class started. Isuru and Lahiru regretted that Taekwondo class was canceled last week. That's why they were excited about the class at this week. After we arrived at YMCA, we changed clothes into Taekwondo uniforms and waited for children. There were four children joined the class. PIYUMI I felt that elders became lonely when I visited Elders House. What I had to do was to be their sister as doing our project.

SANDUNI The government managed Elders house, but many elders felt oppressive because of limited free time. A director explained about facilities, and we would paint and clean the House's rooms. It looked like being great as Korean Elders House. I want to visit the House many times if it is possible.

LAHIRU Elders looked peaceful, but they were controlled without free time. It made me serious to think a meaning of life and happiness. Also, I imagined if I become elder without any help or support. It was very miserable to think about that. Should I be silent to speak out with elders? I don't know, but I'm not afraid of talking with them in Elders House.

Our first Korean Class opened the door on Friday 19th March. Before the class, we made handbills and handbooks for several days referring to a couple of Korean teaching books which we brought from Korea and a big notice paper hanging in front of YMCA. Most of Sri Lanka people speak Sinhalese and English, so the paper was made in both languages. At 6pm, there was only one student sitting in the class. We were all disappointed because we expected at least 10 students to attend. However after 5minutes, two more students joined our class. Now we had 3 students and one of them was the human right coordinator of YMCA, Meranga.

We began the class with collecting information of the students. On the white paper given by us, they wrote their names, ages, jobs and purposes of attending this class. After that we distributed the handbooks we made. Maduri was the main teacher and each of members became a private tutor with a student. At the middle of the class, students suddenly increased to 10. Teenagers chatting and hanging around outside came and joined the class. We taught the conversation first. "An Nyung Ha Se Yo", "Man Na So Ban Gap Soup Ni Da" Korean phrases came through their mouths and filled the classroom. Some students were so smart that they easily understood what we taught. We gave them some homework to write Korean alphabet they learned today. We hope that all the students do their homework and come to our class next Friday.

ISURU I couldn't do well because it was my first time. However, I could be changed to do anything when I saw teammates who were enthusiastic about teaching Korean. Furthermore, there were some people who wanted to work in Korea. Thanks to awkward pronounces, I enjoyed laughing, and I was happy to teach Korean. **MADURI** I like teaching something. I have taught children English many times. But I wanted to teach Korean as well. So this Korean class was an opportunity for me. I am a main teacher of the class and I am satisfied with that. Most of the students concentrated on the class and did very well. However some students couldn't get their own teacher and seemed to have difficulties to follow. Next time I should break the class into small groups and make it more efficient. **PIYUMI** Although the class began on time, there was only one person; it made me nervous. How we do Korean class? However as time was passing, some people came to the class due to learning Korean language. The class was full of about 10 people. It was very difficult for me to teach something. **SANDUNI** Korean, which is called Han Guel, is scientific language. Korean could look like being hard compared to Sinhalese which looked beautiful. Many Sri Lanka people wanted to learn Korean for working in there. I couldn't provide job for them, but I hoped the class could be helped for them. **LAHIRU** About ten people came to the class. They enjoyed how to speak Korean and how to make words. When they understood meanings and principles, they asked questions a lot. They were good students to make us happy. Some people were interested in Korean girls, so they used to ask who Sanduni was. Most importantly, I could learn new Sinhalese from them.

17. VISITING UNDERPRIVILEGED CHILDREN

Flies. Maduri talked about when she was in India. "If you see how to dry Mango, you cannot eat that seriously." Many flies put on the yellow Mango, and rose to the Sky like a storm. A weather was hot and damp because of the river. Houses were built by weak woods which could be destroyed easily. There were a lot of trashes and garbage rotten around houses. Many flies were rotating in the air from the entrance to the river.

When I thought about one girl who grabbed my hands, I didn't want to say about flies first. However, I couldn't also say about the children because the poor environment was very shocking. I used to hesitate to grab children's hands because of flies and decayed environment.

Also, many children welcomed RaonAtti team as smiling and looked shy. One elder said "A U Bo Wan", but his tooth were decayed and looked like blood pus.

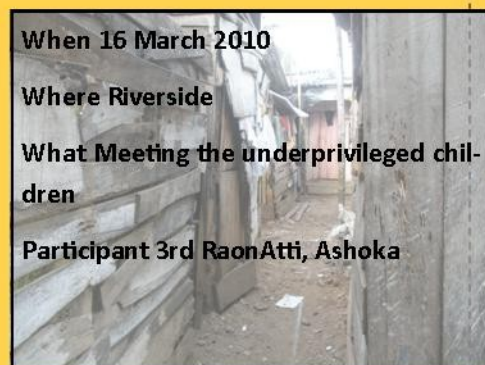
ISURU We visited the poor village for children who couldn't be educated due to poverty. It was more serious than what I imagined. There was no washroom and bathroom, so the poor people should use public those. Most importantly, it was same for the poor children to have pure eyes and good smile. In summary, it was inconvenient for me to see children who couldn't be educated basically.

MADURI The place was closer to YMCA building than I thought. Their environment was poor enough. Small needy houses were attached each other and the alleys between houses were too narrow to pass for two people. Bad smell and dirty water was everywhere. However, when we faced people passing through the alleys, everyone greeted us with a bright smile and looked happy. It was quite weird to me. Maybe I am living with too much greed.

PIYUMI When I arrived at the village, I smelled something strange. Trash and food garbage were rotten near the river, and many children couldn't wash to cause dangerous hygiene. Above all, I looked my good shoes as recognizing children who didn't take shoes. It made me painful to think about life.

SANDUNI I couldn't communicate with the poor children. I could just speak with English. They couldn't be educated, so I was responsible to taking care of them and preparing how I could do. It didn't matter about appearance, but I was afraid of having a prejudice made by first impression. I wanted to be a teacher who would give them hand first.

LAHIRU The poor children were accustomed to flies and living near deteriorated river. However, they followed RaonAtti team with pure smile. Between houses and houses, there was a way for only one person. For me, it was very small and uncomfortable to walk the way. On the other hand, it could be comfortable and familiar for the poor people to walk the way.

Ashoka was very good teacher; his pronounce was more likely soft to hear easily. It was fantastic for me to learn beautiful language. Sometimes they just sat in a chair looking away or reading newspapers. But most of the time they liked talking with us. I imagine their routine. Getting up, every meal time with the bell ringing, talking with the same person yesterday, sleeping in a small room without a fan...It's too much boring. Anyway they were really nice and sometimes encouraged us cleaning the floor with thinner. I think it was a good experience both physically and mentally.

LAHIRU There were so many frames to paint in Elder's Facilities. I needed to paint slowly because it was first time. In there, grandmothers stared at what I was painting for a long time. I looked her eyes, and felt agony of elders. It was something about life. I learned to be slow, delicate and patient from painting. For two days, we painted a half of frames of Elder's facilities. That made me unsatisfied about lacking of time and diligence.

25. Herbal Drink Project

On March 26, RaonAtti team woke up at 5 o'clock to prepare Herbal Drink. They became accustomed to blending, squeezing, filtering and boiling herbs. 3rd RaonAtti team decided to divide their assignments related to the Herbal Drink. They were responsible to take each parts of the project. For example, Sanduni and Piyumi were blending herbs alternately. Isuru and Lahiru were squeezing and filtering herbs to get the drink. Maduri were cooking rice and garlic to put in the drink that would be boiled and blended. Despite RaonAtti team had breakfast a little; they concentrated on making Herbal Drink for people waiting in Hospital. When they put salt in Herbal Drink, their sweat was also put in there because of hard-working personality. In other words, their sweat was transformed into salt; they were hard-working type of people. After making Herbal Drink, RaonAtti team took taxi called 'Bajaj' to go to hospital. They arrived at hospital and distributed Herbal Drink. The drink effects would be great for some people suffering from diabetes. It would make them healthy and wholesome to prevent deterioration from the disease. In this time, they changed roles each other; for instance, Sanduni distributed the drink with Ashoka. Maduri and Piyumi collected cups which patients once used. Isuru and Lahiru washed those cups. Time passed fast, and many people smiled softly as saying 'Delicious, and Thank you.' RaonAtti team decided to recognize how this project would be effective for people suffering from diabetes. As like herbal drink looked green, their life would be vital cheerfully. BY LAHIRU

SANDUNI At this time, I distributed Herbal Drink to patients. There were some diabetes patients who got notes related to records of life. In procedure of making Herbal Drink, Some Sri Lanka rice was put in there. That's why many people left rice. It made them uncomfortable and difficult to drink. Is there any good idea to solve this problem?

PIYUMI I could prepare herbal drink fast compared to last time because I became accustomed to making the drink. When there was a burnt smell of mixer, I felt fearful. However, I endured that and tried to work hard. I was worried if somebody took a cup, so I should look around nervously. Many patients drank the beverage deliciously, so I thank them.

MADURI I feel this job so much valuable every time. This time also many patients came to drink. They all said "Thank you" while they were taking the drink and returning cups. However the important thing about this drink is that it is only for diabetics. We can recognize diabetics by their daily diabetic notes. I should strongly keep this rule next time.



LAHIRU Thanks to Herbal Drink project, I became accustomed to waking up early morning. I could feel fresh air of dawn, and heard various birds' sound. In the hospital, patients drank the herbal beverage, and said 'Thank you'. It was just one or two words, but it caused happiness.

ISURU It was a little hard for me to wake up at early morning for Herbal Drink, but I couldn't comprehend how the morning time passed because I was busy to wash cups. In this week, I was wrong to put cups on the ground because it might cause disease from germs. I would be careful to keep hygiene next time.

26. Korean Language Class

Every Friday is the busiest day of the week. In the morning, we make herbal drink and distribute it at the hospital. Afternoon, we take Sinhalese class and sometimes we lead Children's club. The last program of the day is our Korean class.

At 18:00, the class room had been still empty. We were expecting the students who came to the class last time to come again but a little bit disappointed. Ashoka said, in Sri Lanka, people are usually late for 30 minutes, so we don't need to worry.

After 30 minutes, it turned out to be true. Veranga, the human rights coordinator and our student at the same time, took more than 10 children to the class. I was lack of handout in 10 seconds and the class room was full of young students whose ages were between 15 ~ 17. Most of them were learning Korean for the first time, so we started to teach from the Korean alphabet again. Children followed the class very well but there were two adult students feeling bored in the corner of the room. One of them was the smartest and passionate students, so Sanduni took the student outside and had one to one class. Maduri standing in front of all the students led the class, and Isuru, Piyumi, Lahiru sat beside of children and corrected them if they speak and write wrong. All the students were like baby birds with big opened mouth waiting for their mommy bird to feed them. They absorbed what they learned like sponge and their pronunciation was also very good. Maybe next time we will break the class into two such as high and low according to student level.

BY MADURI

MADURI Teaching children was familiar with me, because I taught children English many times before in Korea. Although I am not sure that how much learning Korean will be helpful for children, I think spreading Korean language in the world is quite valuable and attractive job. Somebody might say that it is imperialistic. However, in Asia, we communicate each other only through English. I think that is so sad and catastrophic. There are thousands of languages in this world but there is only one language through which we understand each other, and the most important thing is that English is not Asian language. Every Asian speaking all the Asian languages is impossible. Then, if there is one more language in which all Asian people can speak, and if it is Korean language, how would it feel? As a citizen of Korea, if many people in the world speak and love Korean language, I think it would be great and so much proud.

LAHIRU At that time, I was so tired. There was a little energy to speak Korean, but many people spoke Korean loudly and learned joyfully. I needed to control and manage my condition. Occasionally, I imagined I spoke Sinhalese and Sri Lanka people spoke Korean. I will try to speak Korean and Sinhalese.

PIYUMI Many students joined Korean class compared with last class. It made me joyful, but I was sorry about that I didn't prepare extra teaching materials for some children.

SANDUNI There was special student who took Korean class from 2nd RaonAtti team. I guessed that he studied hard; therefore, he was good at speaking Korean. Because of high ability, he got an individual tutor. As I enjoyed Sinhalese class, I hope he would be pleasant to take Korean class. I would do my best without private mind. Kkk(he is 19-year-old boy.)



27. SINHALA LANGUAGE CLASS

On March 26, there was RaonAtti team who came to Moratuwa YMCA for studying Sinhalese. The class began since last Wednesday, and this was second time. RaonAtti team waited for Ashoka, who is Sinhalese teacher and coordinator, for an hour. When they looked at 7 cockroaches which attached on wall and got feared, Ashoka came to the class gaspingly. He inspected homework thoroughly and pointed out some problems and wrong things. He said 'If you didn't homework, you would go out!' They were afraid of that saying. The class was continued subsequently, and ended for next class.

BY PIYUMI

SANDUNI It was Sinhalese class with 7 cockroaches. I saw Sinhalese alphabet one time and cockroaches one time. I couldn't focus on the class. Finally, I learned every Sinhalese alphabet, but it was very difficult for me to remember those. Sinhalese alphabet could look different due to various style of writing.

ISURU Last class was canceled on Wednesday, and this class was scheduled on Friday. It was very busy day due to a lot of homework. In addition, it was hard to pronounce Sinhalese in the classroom. Ashoka was not satisfied by my homework, so I needed to write again. Well, I was curious about what I would learn next class.

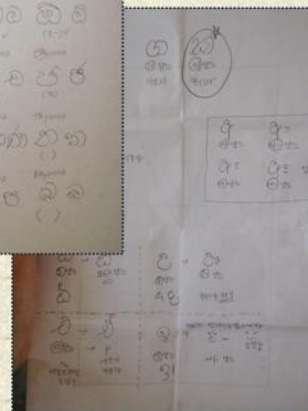

“피부가 흰여자는 쉬운 여자?!”

Mount Lavinia Beach에서 있었던 일이다.

처음으로 맞는 일요일이었다. 아직 스리랑카에 온지 얼마 되지 않아 보고 싶은 것도 듣고 싶은 것도 넘칠 정도로 많았다. 휴일에도 YMCA로 놀러 온 우리가 심심해 보였던지 코디네이터 아쇼카가 해변으로 놀러 가자는 제안을 했다. Moratuwa YMCA에서 버스를 타고 20분 정도 거리에 있는 Mount Lavinia beach는 스리랑카에서 유명한 곳이었다. 버스에서 내려서 해변까지 걸어가는데, 휴일이라서 그런지 거리가 해변으로 가는 가족들과 친구들로 북적대고 있었다. 새로운 곳, 그것도 바다를 본다는 것에 들떠 있던 와중에, 옆으로 바짝 지나가는 차를 피하느라고 급히 금선이 뒤로 위치를 바꿔야 했다. 그런데 갑자기 내 허리를 집게손가락과 엄지손가락으로 살짝 꼬집는 듯한 느낌에 깜짝 놀라 뒤를 돌아보았다. 지팡이를 짚고 중년정도 되어보이는 스리랑카 남자가 바로 뒤에서 있었는데 본인도 조금 놀랐는지 황급히 “sorry” 라고 하였다. 미안하다는 말을 들었는데도 이상하게 기분이 나빴다. 내가 갑자기 앞으로 끼어들어서 간격 유지를 위해 그렇게 한 것이겠거니 하고 상황을 이해하려 노력하면서 금선에게 이 이야기를 했다. 그러자 금선이 하는 말이 내가 버스에서 내렸을 때 길에 서있던 어떤 남자가 내 엉덩이를 손으로 만지려고 했고, 그것을 본 금선이 얼른 나를 끌어당겨서 그 상황을 모면할 수 있었다는 것이다. 기분이 두 배로 이상해졌으나 곧 나타난 바다의 시원한 파도가 모든 것을 쓸어 주었다.

해변에는 사람들이 정말 많았다. 한 여름에 우리나라의 해수욕장을 연상시켰는데, 모든 사람들의 피부색을 갈색으로만 바꾸어서 생각하면 맞다. 바닷속에 들어가 있는 사람들은 90%가 남자들이었고, 여자들은 별로 없었다. 수영복을 입고 있는 여자들을 한 번 봤는데, 그들이 전부였다. 아마도 보수적인 스리랑카의 분위기를 반영한 결과일 것이다.

바다의 아름다운 수평선을 감상하고 있는데, 아까 내 뒤에서 허리를 꼬집었던 남자가 이쪽으로 걸어오고 있는 게 보였다. 오른손에 짚은 지팡이를 보고 단번에 그 사람임을 알 수 있었다. 옷은 온통 하얀색이었는데 차려입은 느낌이었고 느끼하게 생긴 얼굴엔 안경을 끼고 있었다. 뒤에는 따라다니는 남자까지 있는 걸로 보아 부유한 사람이라는 인상을 받았다. 금선에게 아까 그 사람이 저 사람이라고 가르쳐주자 금선이 놀란 얼굴로 말했다. “언니! 아까 내가 말한 사람도 저 사람이었어!”

아 기분이 정말 나빴다. 그 사람이 나를 의도적으로 쫓아오고 있었던 것이 아닌가. 내 표정은 썩을 대로 썩어있는데, 그 사람이 아쇼카에게로 다가와서 말을 걸었다. 나는 근처에 있는 것조차 싫어서 뒤로 피했다. 한 5분간을 아쇼카에게 무언가를 묻고 듣고 하더니 시종을 데리고 그냥 가버렸다. 나중에 아쇼카에게 무슨 말을 했는지 물어보았는데 충격적인 이야기를 들었다.

스리랑카 이모저모



“He thought that you were Chinese and he asked me how much he could buy you.” 그래서 아쇼카가 우리는 한국사람이고, 그런 일은 하지 않는다고 하며, 당신 맛고 싶냐고 했더니 황급히 가버린 것이라고 했다.

스리랑카 사람들은 우리를 보고 ‘white’ 라 한다. 그에 반해 자신들은 ‘black’ 이라고 표현하며 우리는 피부가 하에서 예쁘다고 한다. 우리는 흰 피부 때문에 어둠 속에서도 모습이 다 보인다면 우스갯소리를 하기도 한다. 길을 가면 사람들이(특히 남자들) 대놓고 쳐다볼 때가 많다. 인사를 하거나 말을 거는 것도 대부분이다. 그들이 우리에게 관심이 많은 것은 단지 우리가 신기하고 반갑기만 해서가 아니다. 피부가 흰 외국인 여자들을 성적 대상으로 여기기 때문이다. 스리랑카 여자들은 성에 대해 보수적이고 수동적이지만, 외국 영화에 나오는 ‘피부가 흰’ 여자들은 매우 적극적이고 개방적으로 보인다고 한다. 그래서 생긴 잘못된 편견이 피부가 흰 여성들은 이미 처녀가 아니며 ‘쉬운 여자’ 라는 것이다. 우리에게 가장 안전한 장소인 YMCA도 예외가 아니다. YMCA에 가면, 10대~ 20대 남자들이 많다. 1층 입구의 바로 오른쪽에는 한 개의 당구대가 넓은 공간을 차지하고 있는데, 그곳은 언제나 포켓볼을 치려는 남자들로 가득 찬다. 몇몇 남자아이들은 포켓볼을 치다가 우리가 지나가면 이름을 부르며 인사를 하기도 하고 미소를 날리기도 한다. 하지만 가끔씩 나는 그들의 눈이 우리를 주시하는 것을 느낀다. 우리가 처음 왔을 때도, “아 재네들이랑 잘 수 있지 않을까” 라고 말하는 남자들이 있었다고 한다. 피부색에 따라 그들이 만들어내는 새로운 잣대는 우리를 그들로부터 어느 정도 거리를 두게 한다. 하지만 그들 개개인이 모두 나쁜 성향을 지니고 있기 때문에 이런 상황들이 발생하는 거라고 생각하지는 않는다. 그들은 그들에게 익숙한 대로 행동하고 있을 뿐, 단지 우리가 서로를 잘 모르기 때문이 아닐까. 서로를 알아가기. 그것은 우리가 지금 이 순간 이 곳에 있는 이유이다.

쌀과 빵을 주식으로 먹는다.

: 스리랑카 한끼 점심식사의 90%는 쌀로 이루어져 있다. 밥보다 반찬을 많이 먹는 한국과는 달리, 쌀을 잔뜩 먹고 반찬은 조금 먹는다. 밥도 집에서 해먹는다고보다 사먹는 경우가 대부분인데, 일반적으로 밥과 함께 커리를 사먹는다. 커리를 먹을 때에는 대여섯개 정도의 반찬을 조금씩 덜어 함께 먹는다. 커리는 한 사람당 일반적으로 100루피~120루피(1000원~1200원)정도 한다. 비싸서 잘 사먹지 않는 볶음밥은 한국 사람들의 입맛에 꼭 맞는다! 반찬보다 밥을 많이 먹는 식문화는 스리랑카의 많은 아저씨, 아주머니의 배가 신더미처럼 불러 있는 이유 중 하나일 것이다. 아침에는 50%정도의 사람들이 식빵을 주로 먹고 30%정도가 쌀을 먹는다. 저녁에도 일반적으로 쌀을 먹지 않는다. 역시 식빵을 먹거나 꼬두 로피, 에그 로피 같은 스리랑카 특유의 음식들을 주로 먹는다.

1. 인도에는 '차이'가 있듯이 스리랑카에는 '떼'가 있다. 실론티로 유명한 나라답게, 스리랑카 사람들은 차 마시는 것을 좋아한다. 오전과 오후 식후에 한번씩 마시기를 즐긴다. 주로 마시는 차 종류로는 생강 맛이 나는 plain tea와 plain tea에 밀크파우더를 넣은 milk tea가 있다. 때로는 milk tea에 커피가루를 넣어서 마시기도 하는데 매우 맛있다. 그런데 이 차는 아주 달고 뜨겁다. 스리랑카는 평균 기온이 31도 정도 되는 더운 나라라서, 땀으로 배출되는 당분을 채우기 위해 설탕을 굉장히 많이 넣어 마신다. 차와 함께 먹는 간식들 역시 때로는 먹기가 힘들 정도로 달다. 또한 더운 기운을 이기기 위해 뜨거운 차를 마시는 것은 '이열치열'이라며 여름에 삼계탕을 먹는 우리나라의 문화와 닮아있다.
2. 모든 사람들이 다 옷을 입고 샤워하는 것은 아니다. 상대적으로 가난한 집에서는 우리가 일반적으로 생각하는 사방이 딱 막혀 있는 집을 짓지 않기 때문에, 샤워실에 구멍이 송송 뚫려 있거나 아예 없는(!) 경우가 많다. 샤워실이 없는 집은 근처의 공용펌프장으로 가서 작고 기다란 수도꼭지가 하나 있는 주변에 서서 빨래도 하고 샤워도 한다. 이 때 가슴 아래로 드레스처럼 몸을 가릴 수 있는 옷을 입는다. 언제나 더운 나라이기 때문에 가능한 일일 것이다.
3. 인도에는 소판, 스리랑카에는 개판! 개를 사랑하는 사람은 스리랑카로 오라! 하지만 털이 길고 예쁜 아이들을 기대해서는 안 된다. 여기 사는 아이들은 모두 털이 짧은 잡종스타일이다. 주인 없이 힘들게 사는 길명어들이 많은 것도 마음이 아픈데, 대부분의 개들이 피부병에 상처들을 달고 있으니 그 괴로움을 말로 표현할 수가 없다. 다 똑같은 개들인데 어느 나라에서는 집 잃은 개 주인 찾아주고 깨끗하게 씻겨서 분양도 시켜주는가 하면, 어느 나라에서는 온갖 질병에 시달리며 평생 거리를 헤맨다.
4. 우리나라의 술자리는 꽤 flexible하다. 반주를 하기도 하고, 식후에 마시기도 하고, 식전부터 냅다 달리기도 한다. 반면에 스리랑카에는 룰이 있다. 술은 항상 식전에 마시고 안주는 아주 조금만 먹기. 그리고 술을 적당히 마신 후에야 저녁을 먹는다. 배고프다면서 안주를 왕창 먹어버리면, 졸지에 매너와 상식이 없는 사람이 될 수가 있다. 이러한 음주문화 때문에 길에 술 취한 사람들을 보기가 힘든가 보다. 우리나라랑 완전 다르죠잉.

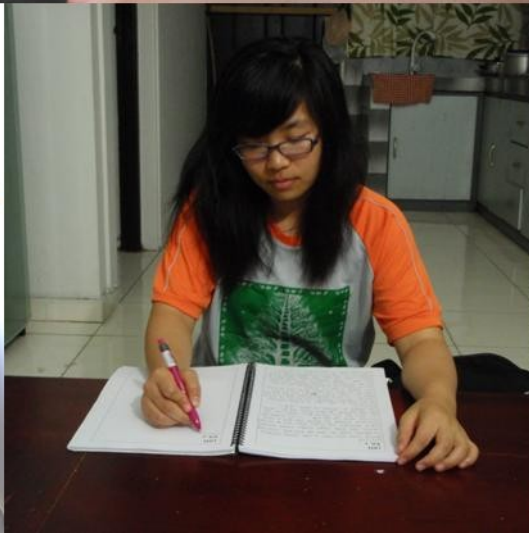

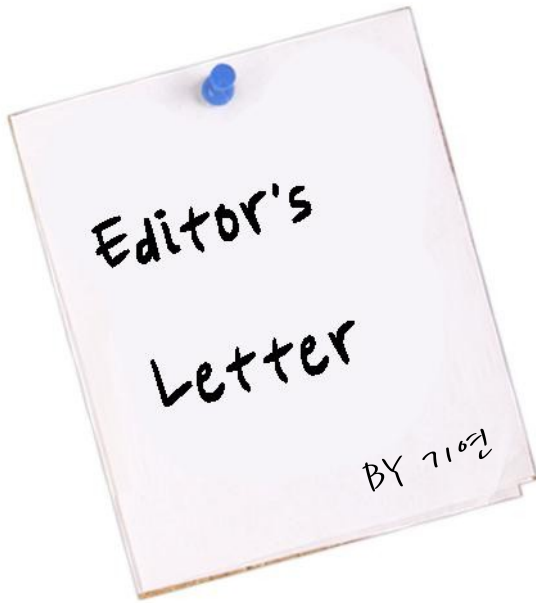
