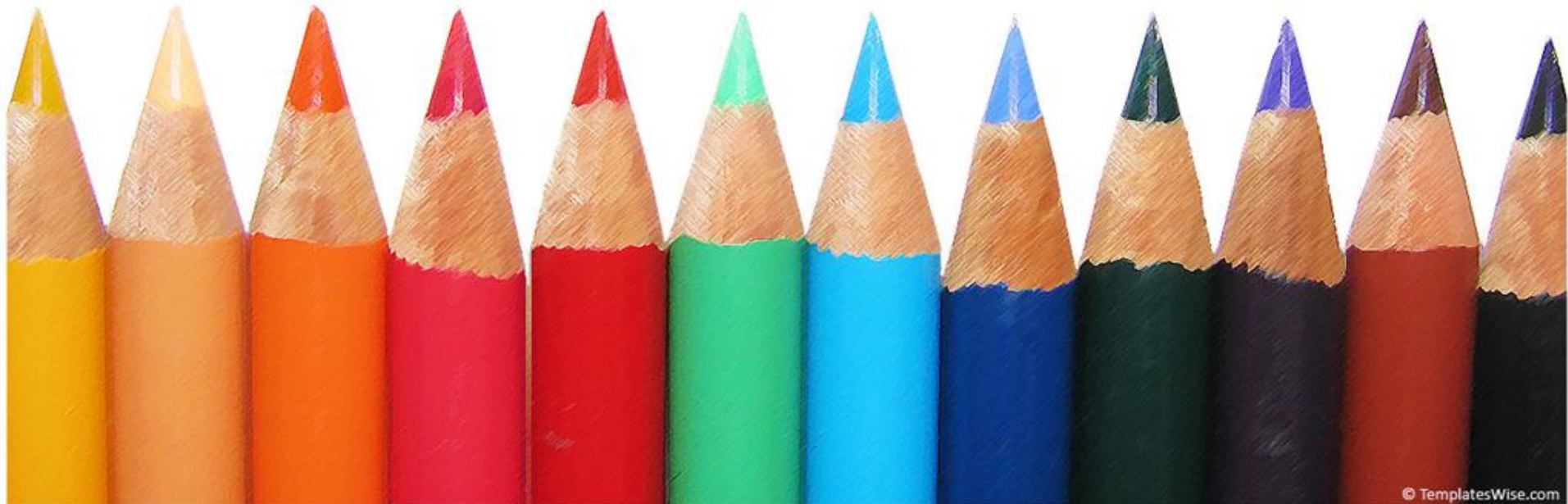

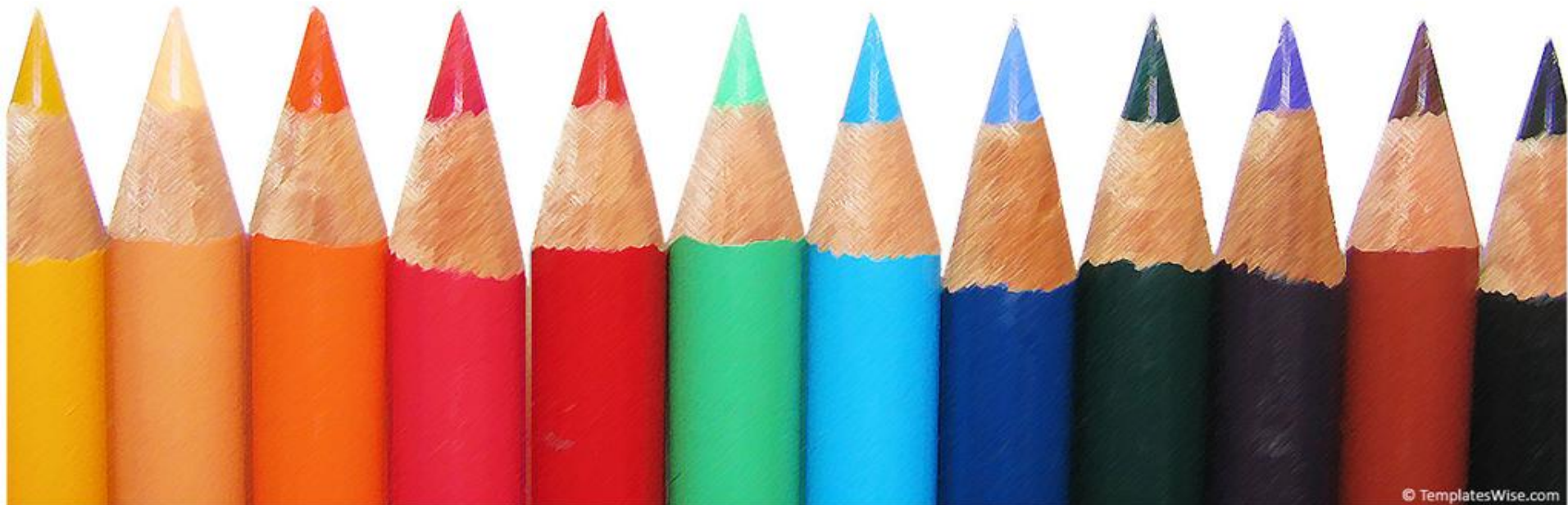

- YMCA volunteer workers including Batang Y
- Raonatti 8th batch (Especially, Jina)

Kailan(when)?

- Tuesday (Lunch – 11:30 a.m.)
- Thursday (Breakfast- 9:15a.m., Lunch-11:30 a.m.)
- Saturday (Breakfast-9:20 a.m.)

To whom?

- On Tuesday: 30 students (Most of them are SM)
- On Thursday: 90 students (Breakfast: SM + M) & 30 students (Lunch: SM)
- On Saturday: 83 students (Breakfast: SM + M + N) – Actual Number: around 30 students
- Based on actual W-H figures given from BGES or special request from teachers in BPES, the feeding list was made.



Saan(Where)?

- At Bagong Pook Elementary School
- Near Public, Corporative Principal, Many malnourished Children, diminishing number of students, having difficulties with budget constraint, Many teachers(based on Dep Ed report)

Ano (What) & how ?

- Breakfast Feeding with Vitameal (Thursday, Saturday)
- Lunch Feeding with side-dish (Tuesdays, Thursday)
- * What is 'Vitameal' – a nutritious mixed grain , donation from BETHESDA

Bakit(Why)?

- To promote the moderate growth of malnourished children in Bagong Pook public elementary school
- Relieve hunger → Children can focus on their class

Bakit?

- The reality of Library in BPES: 1. Students don't come library at all. / 2. Borrowing and bringing books to children's house are not allowed. / 3. The venue is too close to the room of principal. Unlike Suksoo Library, they can't talk while they are reading a book.
- To overcome three major problems of library, we start library program on Thursday and Saturday.
- At the same times, the principal of Bagong Pook also requested us extra program on Saturday.

Ano & how ?

- **Concept: « Moving Library »**
- If children can't come then Raonatti will go.
- Raonatti will bring the books and share with children.
- If we can't talk and play in the library, let's find another spot such as covered court and vacant class room.
- On Thursday, most of after-feeding program is related to making decoration for Library. (Following the rule of self-help)
- On Saturday, we use books in Library Hub or Library of Bagong Pook for reading comprehension program.

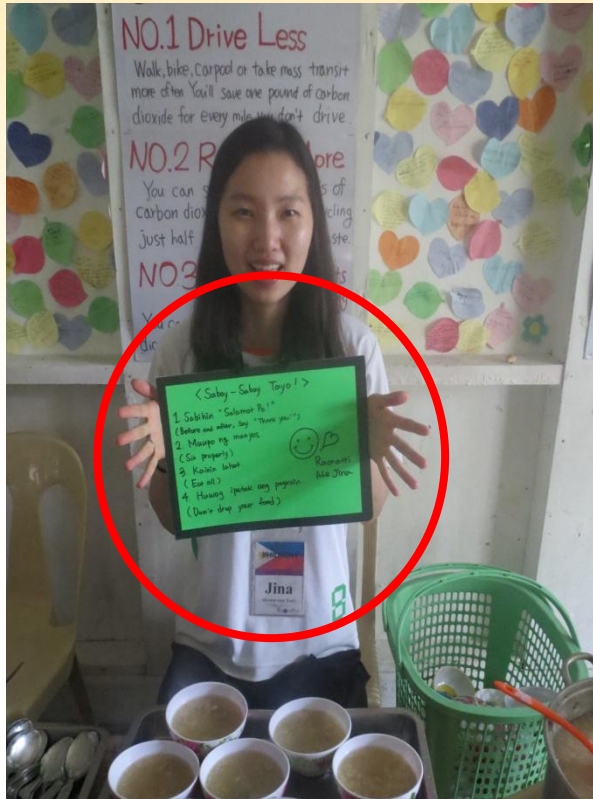

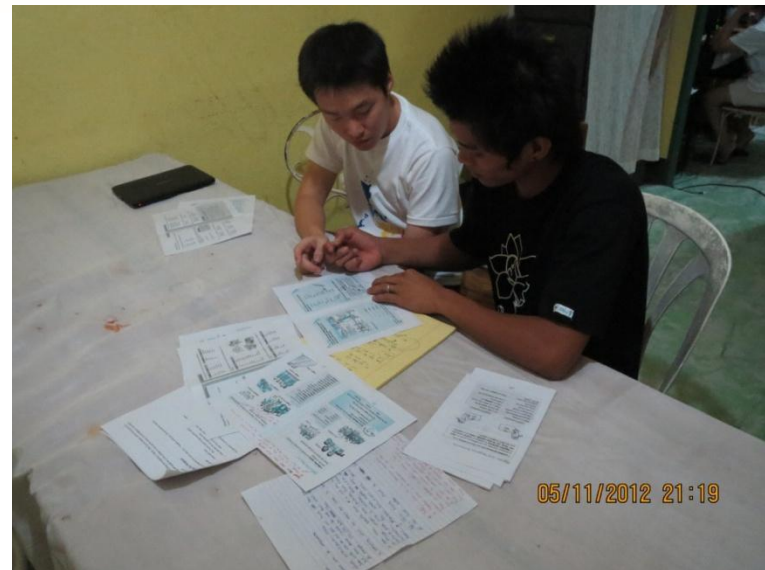

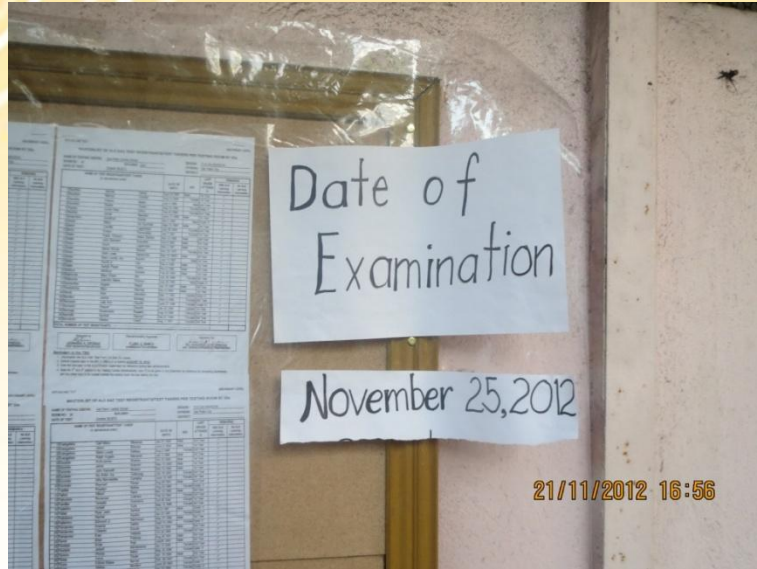
